

FIELD TRIP POLICIES & PROCEDURES

BLOOM ABBOTSFORD TULIP FESTIVAL

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Bloom is an all-weather event and field trips go ahead rain or shine.
- We require a minimum of 20 students to secure your booking.
- We have concessions on-site at additional cost however, your group is invited to pack their own snacks/lunch to enjoy during their visit.
- Please check our website for information about stroller and wheelchair accessibility.
- Bus drivers receive free admission with your group. Be sure to let your driver know!
- School field trip reservations are available weekly Tuesday through Thursday.

PRICING

- \$7 per child
- 1 free adult chaperone per 4 students
- Additional adults \$5
- Siblings not part of the class and over 2 years of age, \$7

PAYMENT

Credit card information is required at the time of booking in order to secure your field trip date and time. The credit card will only be charged in the event of a no-show or last minute cancellation (less than 48 hours prior to the scheduled field trip).

Payment is processed upon arrival for your scheduled field trip and will be based on actual number of attendees. We accept all major forms of payment including credit card, cash and cheques.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you wish to cancel your reservation, we require a minimum of 48 hours notice. If you cancel your reservation with at least 48 hours notice, or you wish to reschedule your reservation for a later date and time in the current season, no charge will be incurred. In the event of a last minute cancellation (less than 48 hours notice) without rebooking for this season or a no-show, the credit card provided upon booking will be charged a \$100 fee.
